The conference aims achieving sharing experiences and best practices on sustainable agriculture, salinity management including biosaline agriculture practices, resources efficiencies and productivities and water management based on ecosystem services, irrigation modernization, conjunctive use of canal and groundwater, closed loop systems in agriculture and water management.

Call For Papers

Authors are invited to submit full (and original research) papers (6-12 pages) including surveys, research and review papers in conference topics of interest through the www.tiiame.uz by April 1, 2020.

Submitted papers will be peer-reviewed by three reviewers on the basis of technical quality, relevance, originality, significance, and clarity. If necessary, a fourth, additional reviewer will be involved. The Program Committee will use these reviews to determine which papers will be accepted for presentation at the conference. The result of the reviewing will be announced to the submitting authors by email, along with reviewer comments, if any.

Accepted papers written in English or Russian will be published in the Conference Proceedings Selected accepted papers written in English and Russian will be negotiated with SCOPUS data base journals for publishing after conference.
